

Second exhibition abroad for hei solar light Intersolar in Munich is to be visited next by HEI

Each lamp preserves the world's climate from up to 2 tons of carbon dioxide emissions. Completely new is the PV-module technology, based on high efficiency, that is integrated into the lamps body. Even on rainy and cloudy days the PV-module collects enough energy for a reliable operation of the light during the night. Therefore the operation of **hei solar light** is also guaranteed in winter and during bad weather periods. The innovative technology presents a lighting solution that is of high efficiency regarding economical and ecological aspects.

During the Intersolar **hei solar light** will be presented to decision-makers of communities, to engineers, architects, professionals belonging to the electronic and lighting business and to investors, who work in the environmental sector. The exhibition located in Munich provides the best framework for HEI.
